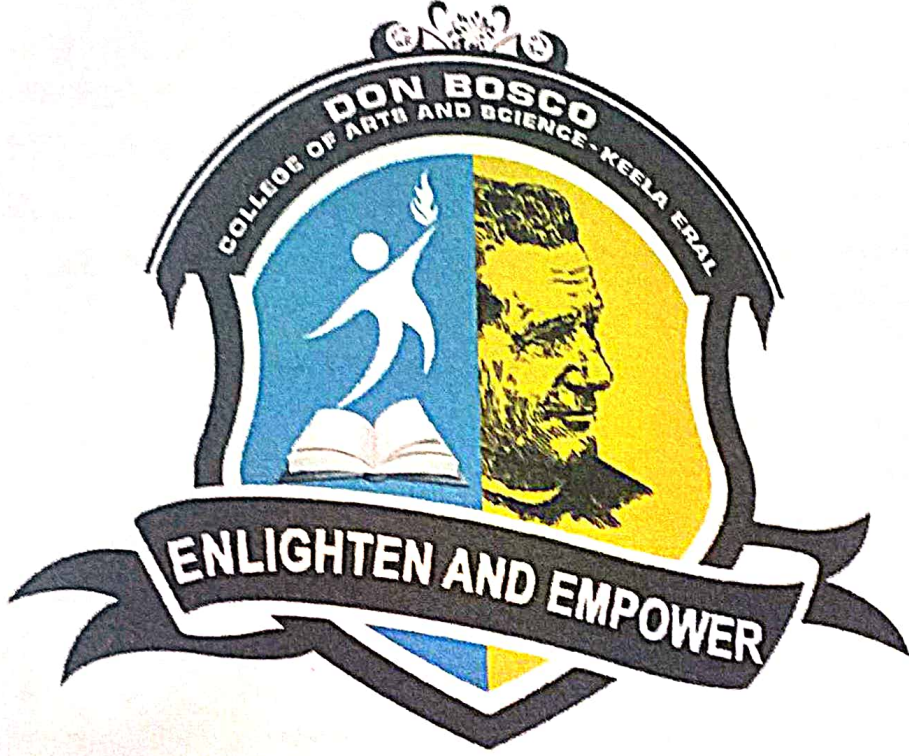

- On 7th December at 3.00 P.M. we are leaving from the village and 4.00 P.M. reached our college with the students.

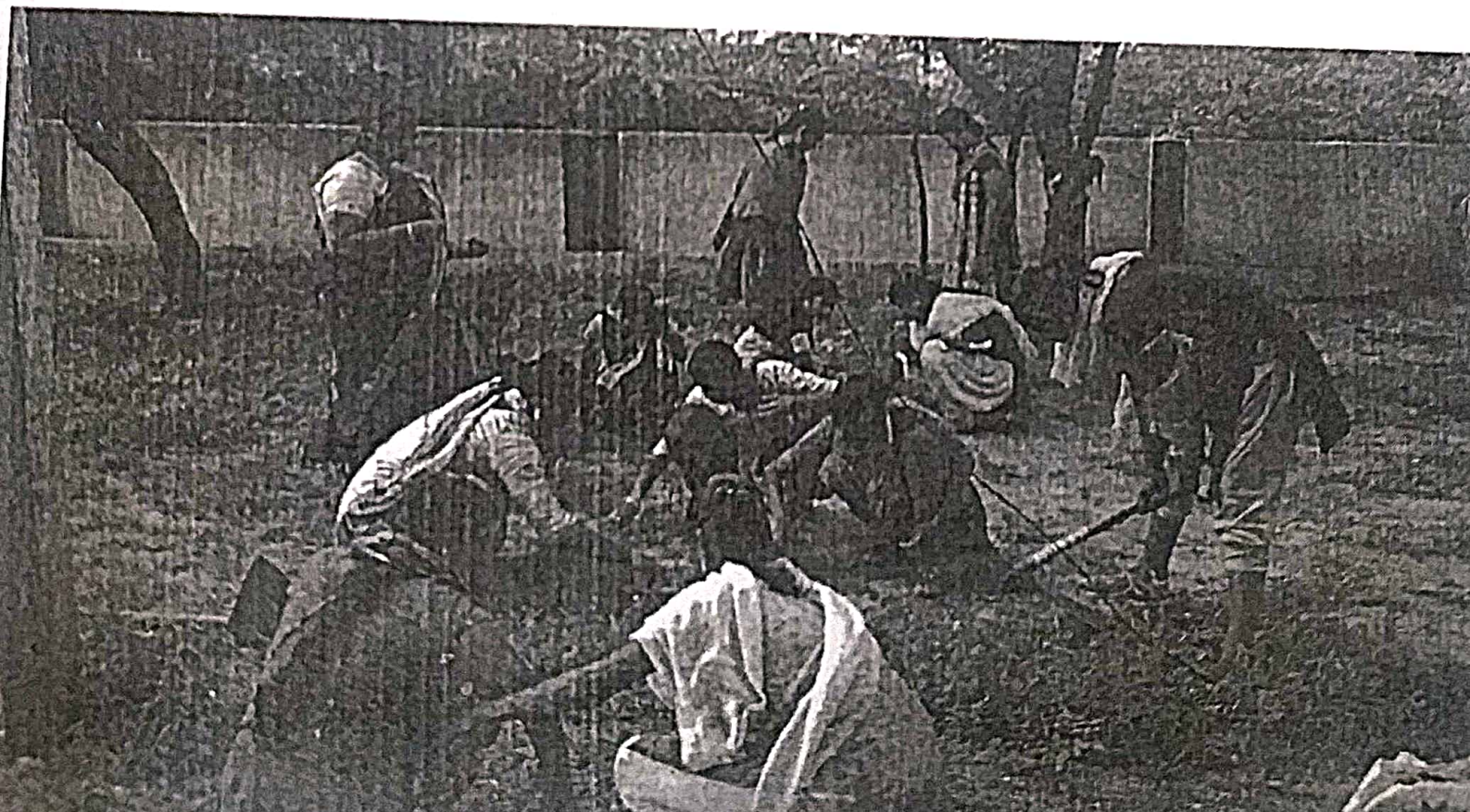

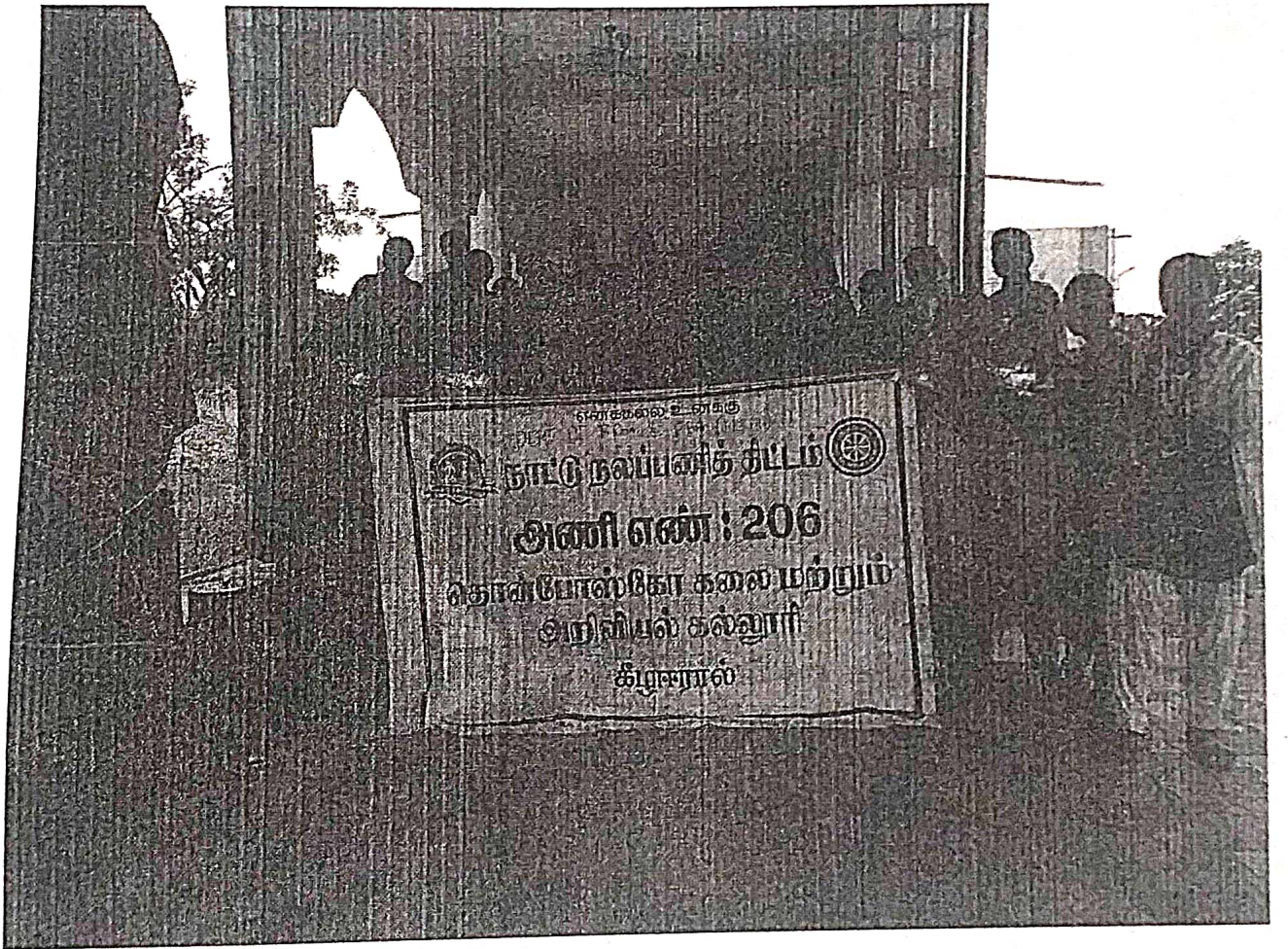

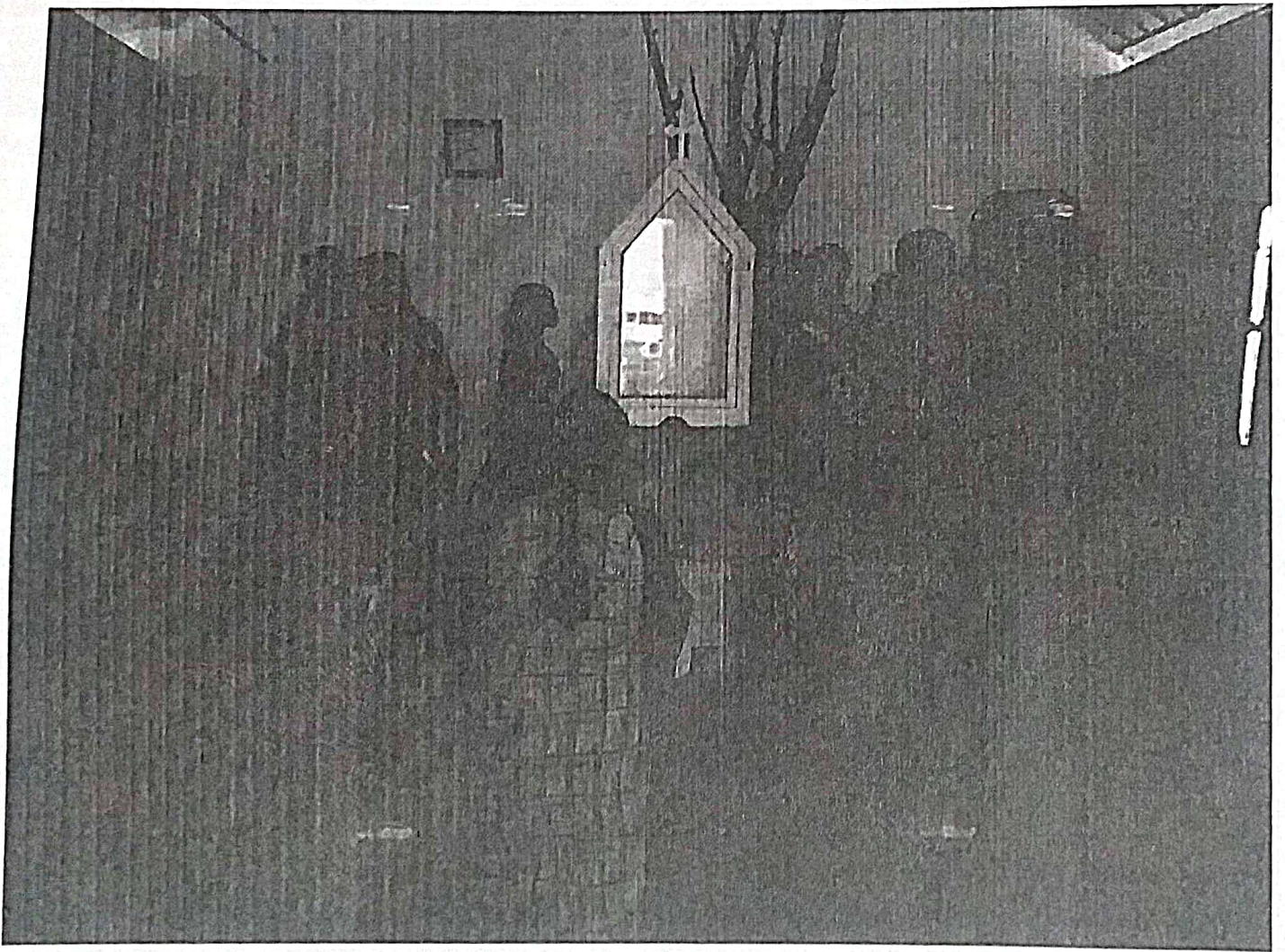
EXTENSION ACTIVITY REPORT OF THUPPASIPATTI (2019)

Seventeen 16 students from BBA Department and 30 Students from BCom Department attended the camp.



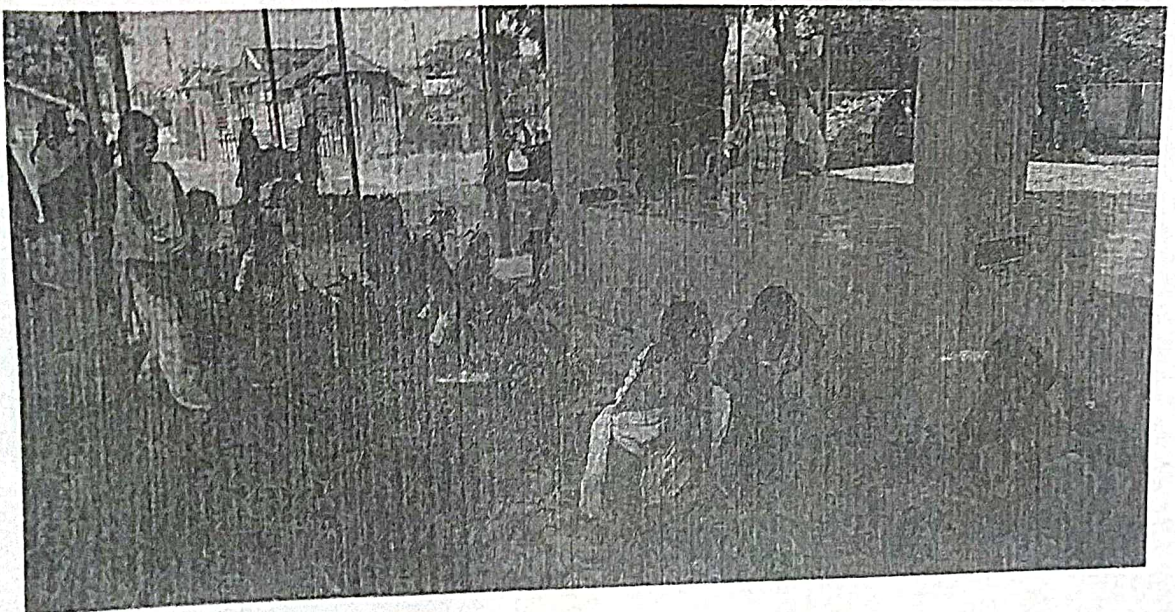
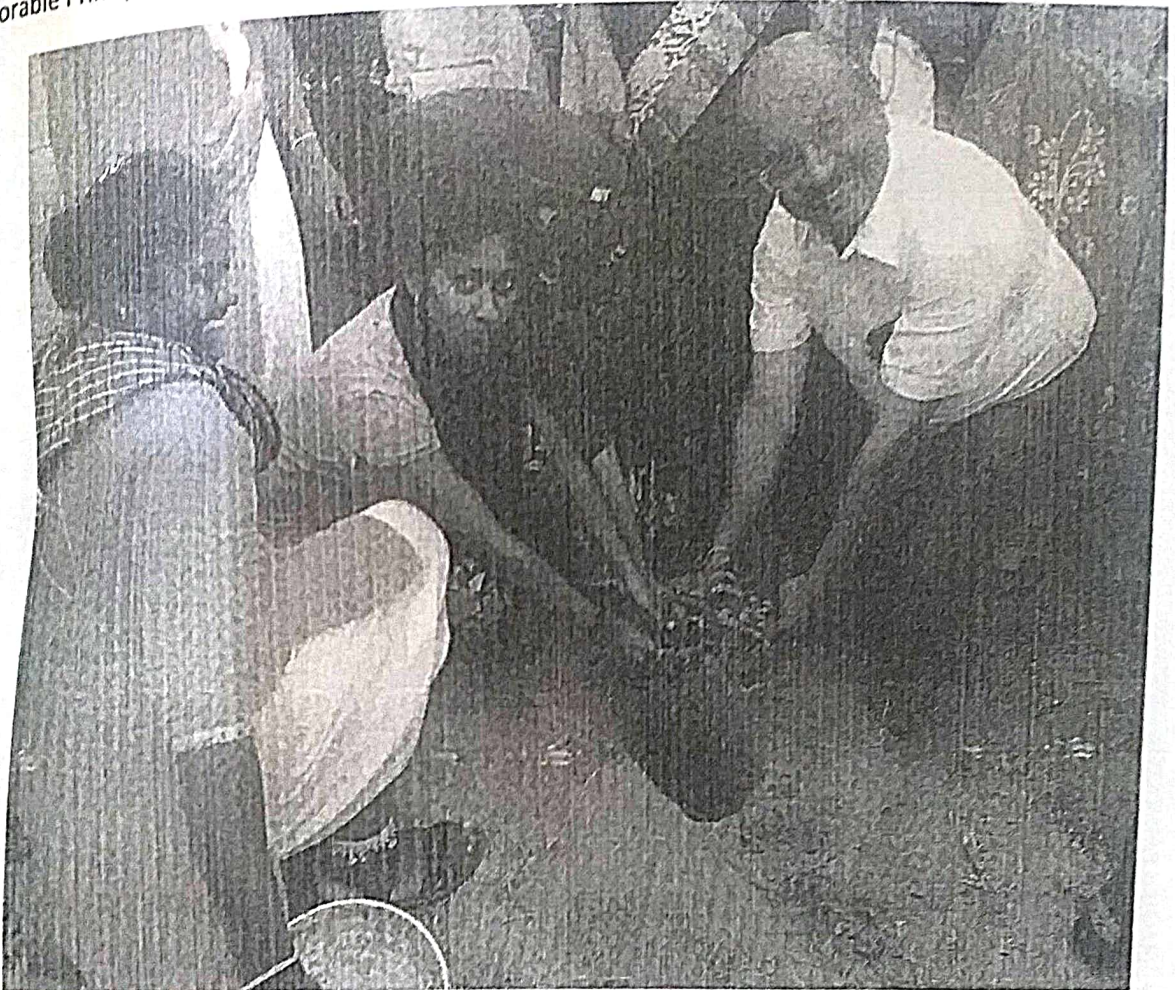
Our Students visited the village and met the people and explain them about the government schemes to the older people, importance of adhaar card and the individual people should have the bank account.

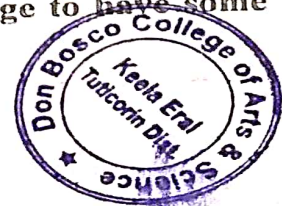
PLANTATION OF PLANT:

The main aim of the rural camp is "Learning to Serve".

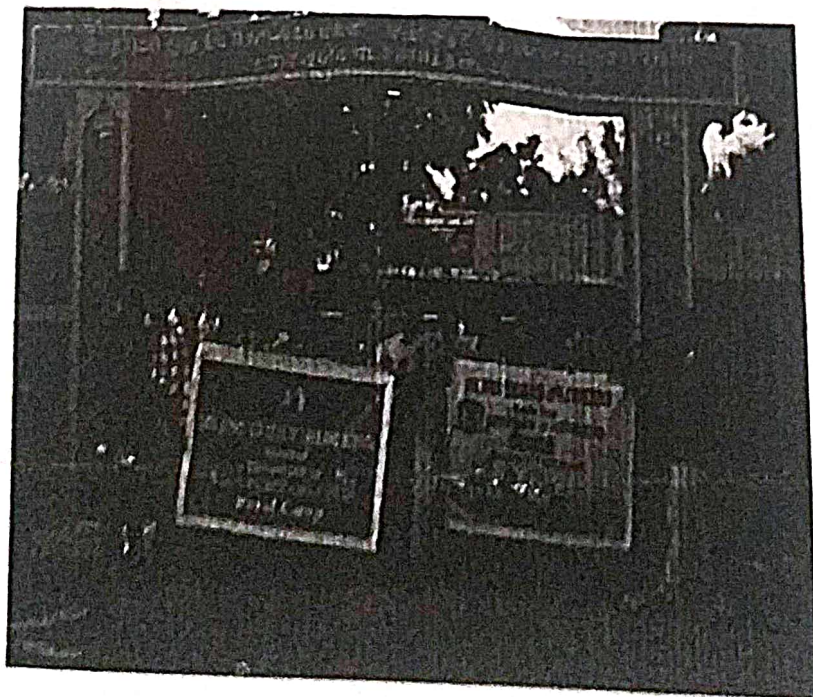
The students should adapt themselves to the environment and adjustable to any situation.

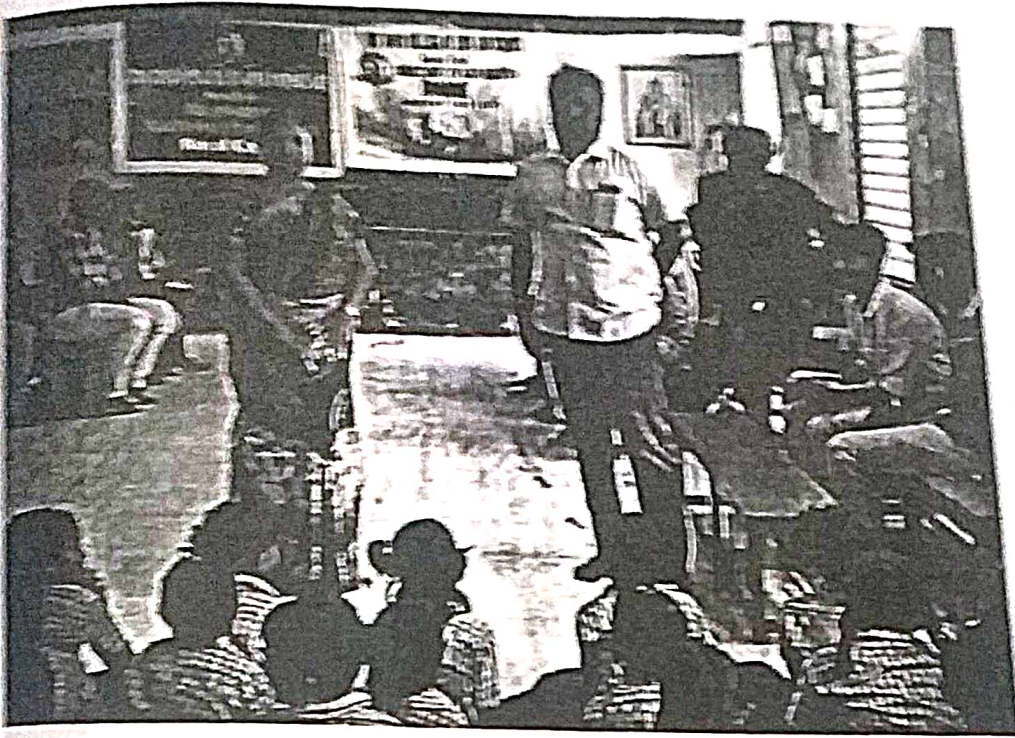
The students should render their service to the needy people and protect the nature.

After lunch, students prepared for the street play and cultural events from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

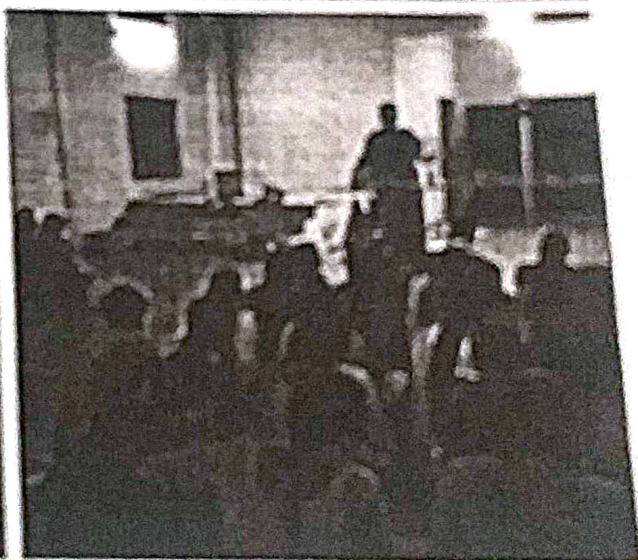
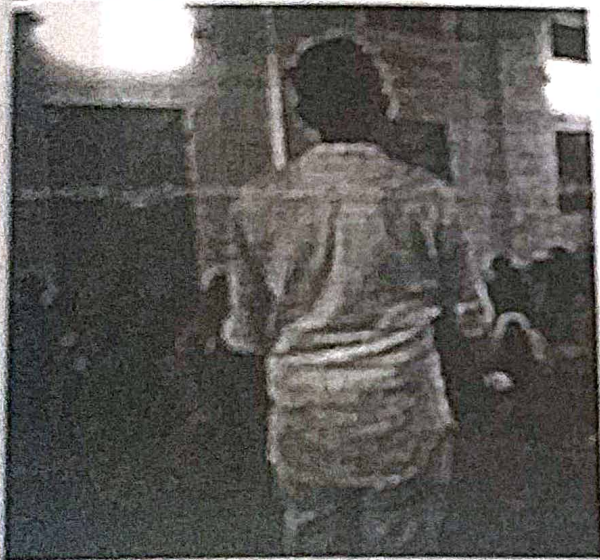

08:00 p.m. Children's Program was given by the students Games were played for the school students of the village and prizes were given. The programme ended by 08:30 p.m.

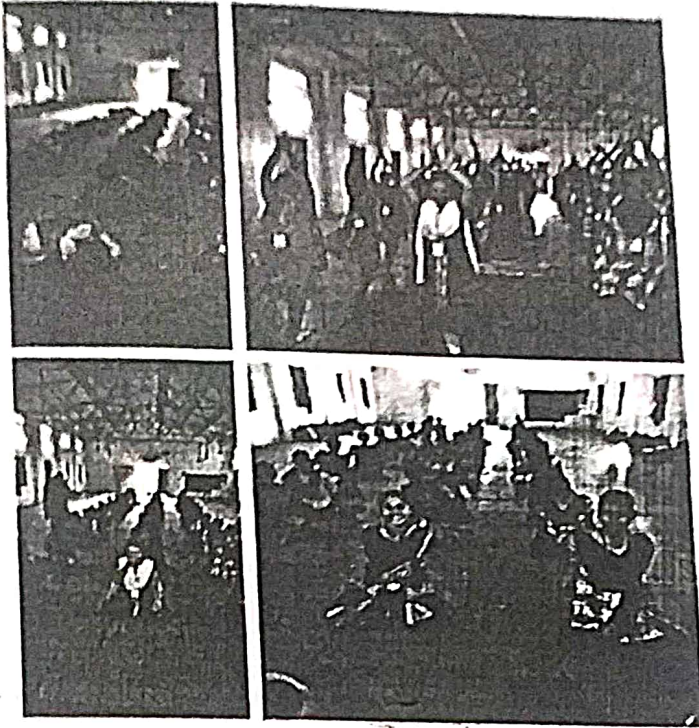

On 8th January 2020 the students woke up by 04:00 a.m. Meditation were done 06.00-06.15 a.m.

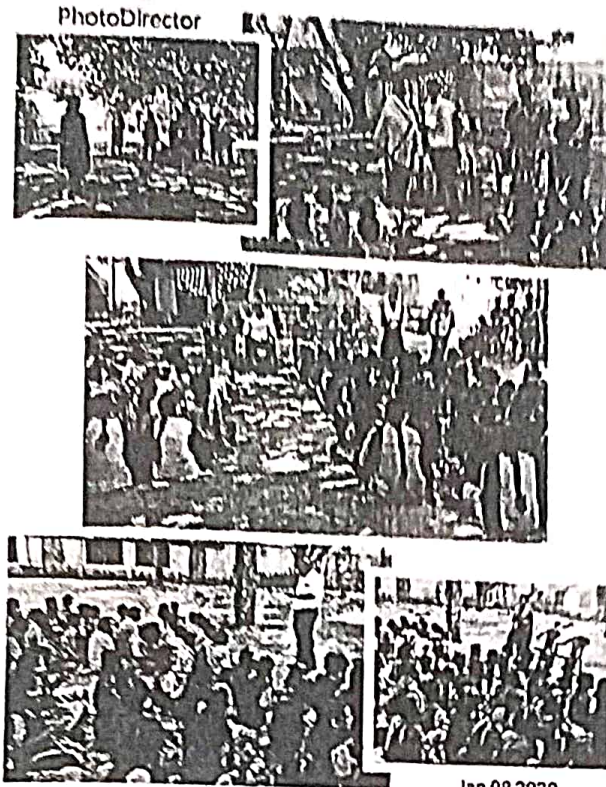


At 08:00 a.m. the students took the break fast. After the breakfast the students their cleaning work (vessels & room).

The students reached the School by 09:30 a.m. They planted some saplings in the school garden. After that, School Program was organized by the students.

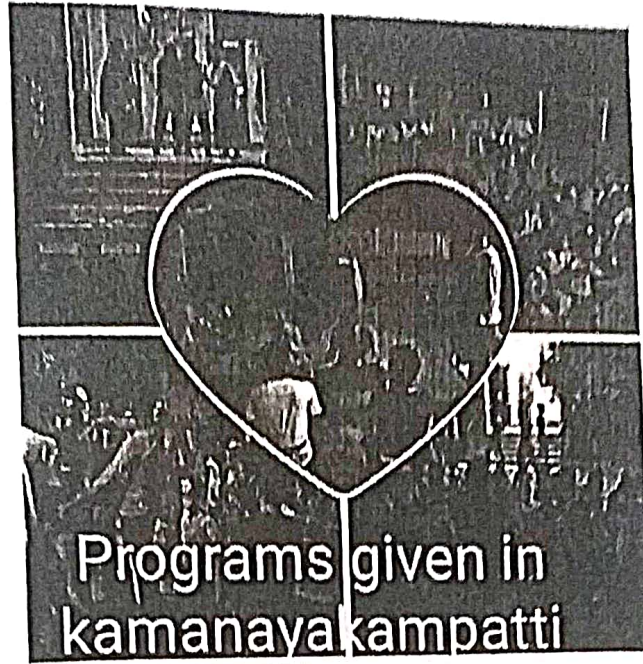

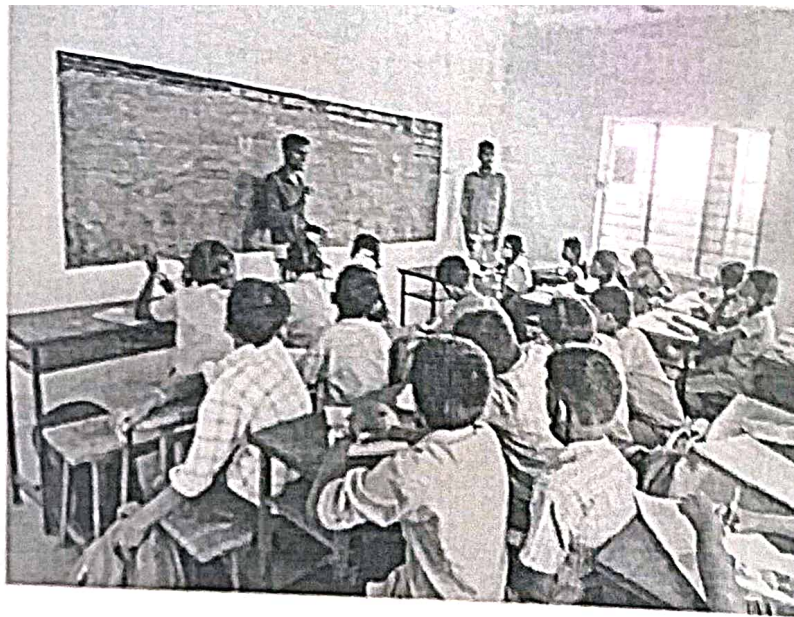
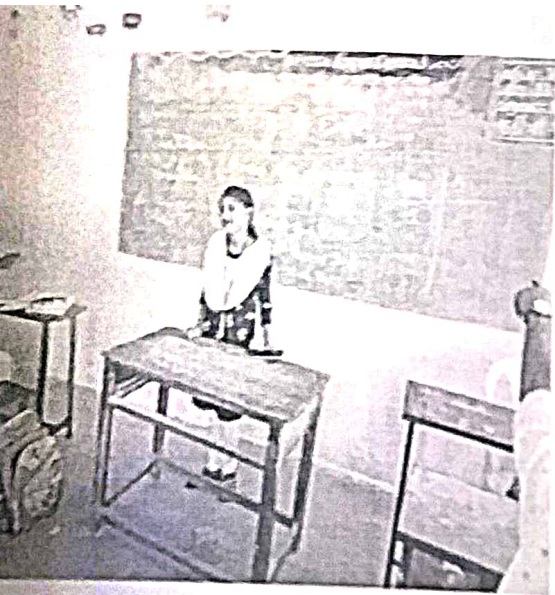
EXTENSION ACTIVITY

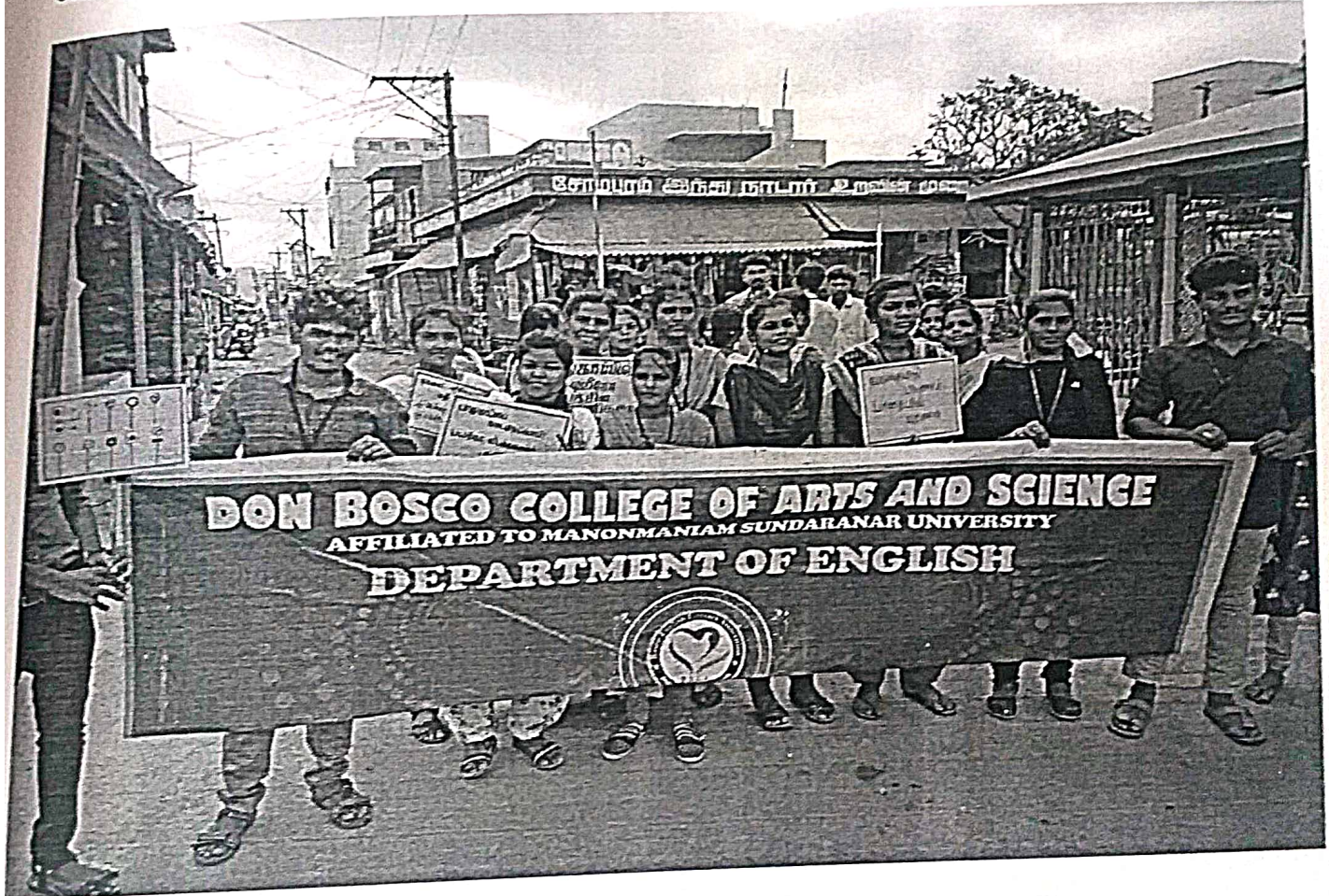

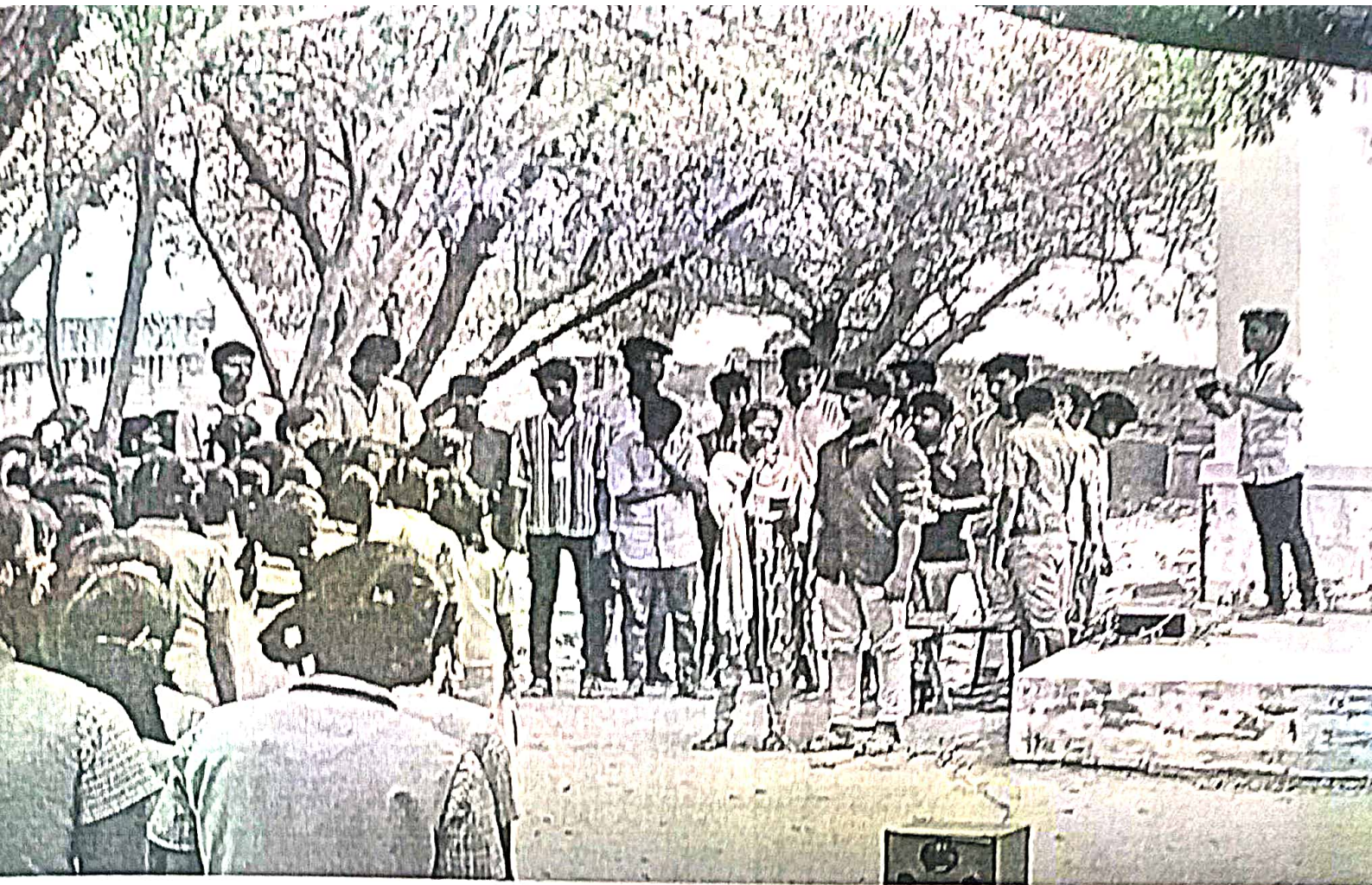

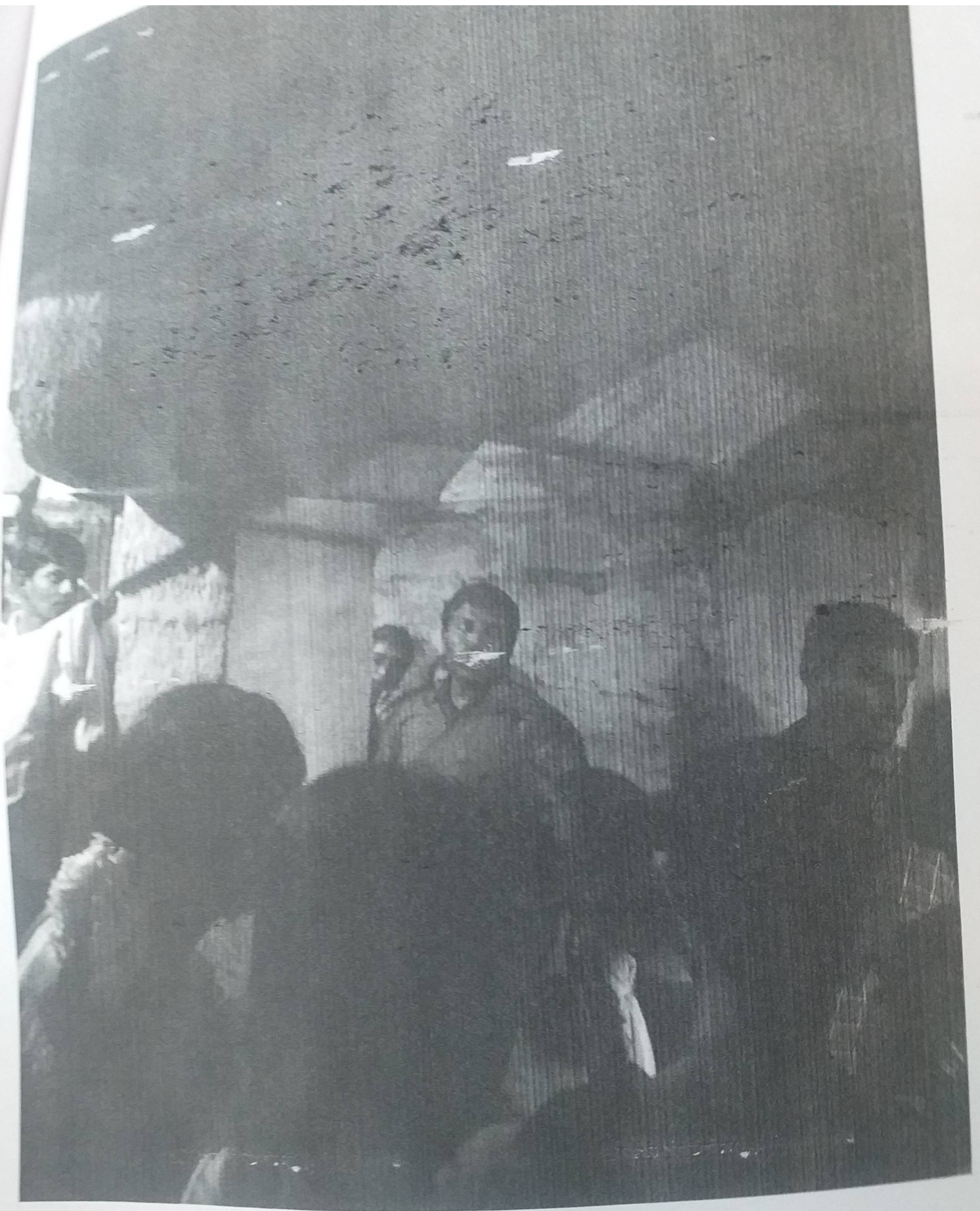

Fresher's Party: Fresher's party for the first UG students and the new faculty members was celebrated by the second and final year UG students on 6 July 2017.



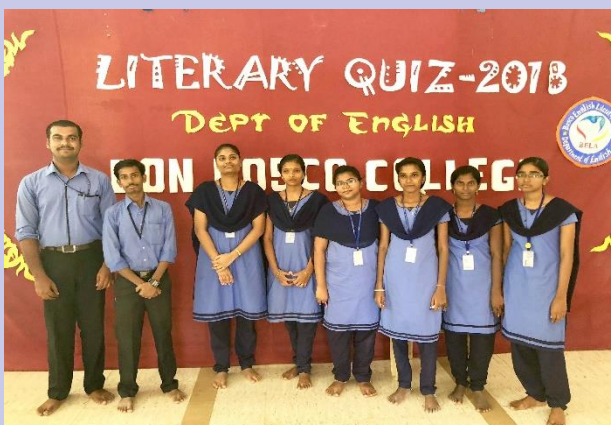


BELA Inauguration: The Department of English inaugurated its Literary Association named BELA which is the acronym of Bosco English Literary Association on 27 July, 2017.

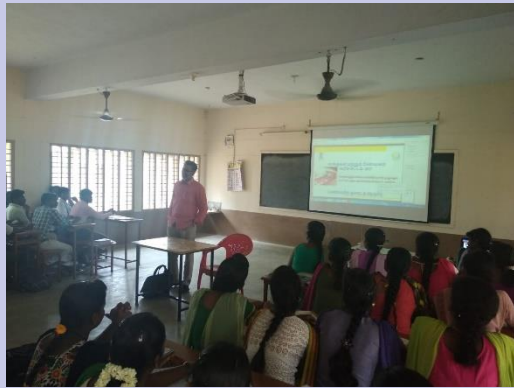
