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INFRASTRUCTURE ADDED:

DBCAS strives to improve sufficient and quality infrastructure and facilities in every way to provide an 'environment of excellence in education' to the students. The College Entrance was constructed with the expense of 18 lakhs in this year. A Printer cum Xerox machine was bought for the Office usage with the expense of 50,000/-. HD surveillance camera was installed in all the buildings of the College Campus with the expense of 1.6 lakhs. And around 1 lakh had been spent for Water Service and Savings.

It was an Inter-Collegiate Literary Competition conducted on 23rd February 2019. This was the third year of the Inter-Collegiate Competitions.
